WASHINGTON COUNTY HOME & COMMUNITY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This program reaches out to Wisconsin children ages 3-5 in families of financial need and gives them the tools to learn. Currently about 225 Washington County children participate at Head Start and 8 child care sites with 16 volunteers in 14 classes.
