The only sewing she had to do was wrap thread around the horn, and stitch it in place on top of the hood.

I come home from the fairs with many ideas of things I would like to make or try, but alas, my regular work awaits me, and not many of those ideas make it into reality. So, speaking of getting back to our regular work, HCE clubs will get back to regular meetings in September and the Board will be working on fall programs, state conference and the district meeting that we will be hosting.
