Another cancer Survivor stopped at the booth to say "thank you" for stitches of love project - It does make a difference!




International Report










Special Service Partners, Neenah, WI donated 2 pallets of these beautiful empty custom made boxes that will work great for the HCE project!



Sheboygan Co. HCE Board Meeting Sept. 11, 2023 DRAF



At 10am we had a meet and greet with new HDR Alicia Utke-Becher. 14 people attended and Joyce Smies had wonderful snacks available.

The meeting was called to order by president Kathi Bonde at 1pm.

Marilyn Voskuil led us in the Association Creed.

A discussion was held on how much time should be allotted between educational meeting and board meeting. It was decided that $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours was sufficient time.

Minutes were read and minor changes on spelling and the word wings, not wheels changed. Alice made a motion and Pam 2nd to approve with changes.

Treasures report was read, Sept. speaker check will be voided as they did not speak. Note money was returned for cancelled liability insurance policy!

Kathi will check at state conference what we are allowed to do about the pennies for friendship if we do not want the money to go to state project. Do we have to change the name when we collect? Are we allowed to give to a local project?

Cultural Arts: Pam Fiedler will get some guestions she has answered about her position on cultural arts at the state conference. She has purchased supplies and will have kits ready to make cards for Camo Quilt project. She hopes to give them 400 cards. Date for making will be Oct. 19 10am-12pm. Bring a glue stick or glue runner if possible. She has all other supplies.

Stitches of Love: Ann Meyer has made up a tote bag of hats to be used for display purposes only. It will be in closet at UWEX. It can be used for the fair booth and tree display at the museum. This will help prevent excess germs on hats given to cancer patients. Please put them back in the bag and storeroom when you are done displaying them. More cutters and sewers are needed. Please call Ann for patterns and material.

HCE Book Club- great discussion was held on last book. Next book will be "Trevor's Song" and will be discussed on Nov. 2. Everyone is encouraged to come even if you don't read the book. Feb. 8 The book will be "The invention of wings" Feb. 2 the book club will be 10 years old! Congratulations to all who attend.

Family and Community Life Outreach: 2024 projects suggested were: Camo guilts, and Fresh Meals on Wheels. Remember to keep track of volunteer hours.

WI Bookworms: Waiting on go ahead to read in October. Althea will pick up book bags at state and was given a check for \$218.75. This will save us from paying postage for shipping them. We are one of the counties that has been with WI bookworms since inception 25 years ago.

International: Alice put together a box of sewing items, from our county, for the silent auction, at state conference. She also personally donated items and encouraged others to do so. The money goes for an international project. There is also a cultural arts raffle to raise money for prizes for the cultural arts contest.

Marketing: Kathi offered purchase items for us from the marketplace at state, if we ordered and paid ahead. Many cute items available to help us promote HCE wherever we go. Tammy would like to see the recipe book kept to 10, 2-sided pages. We felt that with just the recipes that won't be an issue. It was bigger this year because we included picnic games. It was discussed that more contact information be given on the recipe book. Pam Fiedler will look into pricing on bags for the fair to hand out with the recipe books. There doesn't seem to be anyone giving out bags for promotions and people don't like to just carry papers around. Suggestions were to put stickers on bags instead of printing- or put information on handout so it can be seen through bags.

Programming: July tour was greatly received and enjoyed by those who went. She has filled most of the slots for 2024 and is working on tour possibilities for June/July. If anyone has ideas, please let her know. Lake Orchard Aquaponics is one suggestion.

Fair booth: several new names were collected and given to members to contact that may be interested in joining a club. Other organizations were interested in collaborating with HCE. Kathi will follow- up with them.

Member-to-Member if all set for Oct. 9. Make sure you have your 2 recipes per club/individual member to Tammy by Oct. 2.

Althea will be working with Kenosha Co. at the state meeting to finalize how the decorations for next year's conference will look and what we still need to get to finish them. Myra donated some coffee cans, they are smaller than the ones Althea had, so they will need to see if they will still work for project. We will still need some silk flowers, only colors white, yellow, red, black please.

We need people to volunteer for the board positions: treasurer, family & Community Life. Myra said if no one steps up she will take on secretarial duties one more year- but if someone is willing to do it- please speak up.

Fall SE district meeting in in Walworth Co. The speaker will be talking about the 2022 Beijing Olympics. Cost is \$20 and Kathi would appreciate someone going with her to this event. It is Oct. 19 from 10:30-3.

We had a motion by Alice and 2^{nd} by Althea to have a promotional Christmas tree at the Sheboygan Co. Historical museum again this year. Joanne Gadicke and Sharon Even will be in charge, but anyone is invited to help.

Joan Walvoord led us in the Association prayer.

Kathi Bonde president adjourned at 2:50pm.
