1. The Kenosha County Association for Home & Community Education will award educational gifts to prospective students planning to continue their education at an accredited technical school, college or university. Applicants may be a family member (spouse, child, grandchild, niece or nephew or any step-children, etc.) or an individual recommended by a Kenosha County HCE member. Applicants may be a graduating high school senior or a student currently enrolled in a college or university.
2. The number of scholarships and monetary amount will be determined by the committee before the selection process begins.
3. Scholarship recipients will receive the money upon verification of enrollment at an accredited technical school, college or university.
4. Selection is based on academic ability, participation in school and community activities, and personal qualifications.
5. Application for these scholarships is open to individuals regardless of sex, creed, ethnic background or physical handicap.
6. *It is the responsibility of the applicant to make certain the application is complete, including transcripts from their high school and if currently a student at a technical school, college or university, the most recent transcript from that institution must also be included.*
7. *The committee will not consider any applications that are not complete, nor will they contact applicants for any missing information.*
