PURPOSE

- To encourage counties and clubs to be involved in volunteering and providing services to agencies and/or organizations that serve their local communities. This service should benefit or involve the local community.
- To encourage members to learn new things while providing service to others.
- To provide awareness and understanding of Home and Community Education (HCE).

GUIDELINES

- Awards are given to counties whose club projects best offer service to the local community, make a difference for the agency and/or organization and involve HCE member participation.
- Report should cover a major county project done from August 1st of the last conference to August 1st of the current year.

PROCEDURES

- Complete the application information, write a **short** PARAGRAPH summarizing your project, type and answer **ALL** the questions and include supporting materials which illustrate and enhance the report, including photos, brochures, social media posts and news articles.
- Report should be on 8½" x 11" paper (10 pages maximum, 1 side).
- Enclose the report in a **report** cover.
- Mail the completed report by first class mail to **current** Vice President for Family and Community Life.
- Report must be postmarked by the deadline date of **August 1**.
- Reports will be judged using the Services of Love Award Judging Sheet.

Points – up to 2 points per item.

- _____ Were photos, brochures, social media posts or other publicity items included.
- _____ Report is enclosed in a **report** cover (**not a notebook**).

Points – Up to points per item.

- _____ The service was a county-wide project organized and carried out by HCE.
- _____ The county networked with an organization/agency/business.
- _____ Member participation was explained.
- _____ Number of people and what groups served was explained. Also, areas of county and number of times service was performed listed.
- _____ Donated hours listed.
- _____ How the project was promoted and what publicity it received was indicated.
- _____ Duration of Project: Is this project a one-time project or is it on-going?
- _____ Evaluation of project included.

Points – up to 3 points each

- _____ Providing the service was a good learning experience for members who participated.
- _____ Providing the service brought awareness of and publicity for HCE.
